

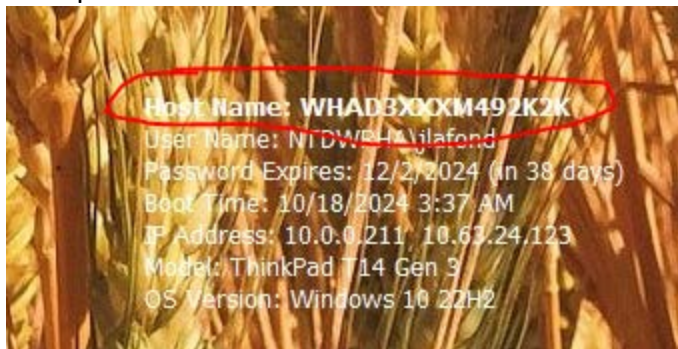
Through the benefit of a federal grant, Shared Health has made a bulk purchase of [Antidote](#) licenses and are assigning a limited number to WRHA for **bilingual staff (French/English)** . You do not need to be in a bilingual position.

[Antidote](#) is writing assistance software with a powerful corrector, rich dictionaries and detailed language guides that will scan your emails for errors before they're sent out and can be used to review your Word documents. Some elements of French grammar can be tricky so the second look provided by Antidote is helpful. This version is bilingual so it will also correct your English documents.

Digital Health has created a deployment package. For awareness, the installation of Antidote is supposed to be automatically pushed out to the users during a system restart. This should happen sometime in November. In the interim, we need to collect information on the employees who would like to have a license.

What we need is the **Host Name** (computer name) found on the employee desktop screen.
