


### Purpose

#### 1. iPhone SE Basics






#### 2. Turn on iPhone

**If turned on,** push once to log the screen, once pushed a passcode will be required to unlock the iPhone


#### 4. Basic gestures to interact with iPhone

Symbol	Gesture
•	Tap. Briefly touch an item on the screen with one finger. For example, to open an app, tap its icon on the Home Screen.
0	<b>Touch and hold.</b> Press an item on the screen until something happens. For example, if you touch and hold the wallpaper of the Home Screen, the app icons begin to jiggle.
1	<b>Swipe.</b> Move one finger across the screen quickly. For example, swipe left on the Home Screen to see more apps.
1	<b>Scroll.</b> Move one finger across the screen without lifting. For example, in Photos, you can drag a list up or down to see more. Swipe to scroll quickly; touch the screen to stop scrolling.
2	Zoom. Place two fingers on the screen near each other. Spread them apart to zoom in, or move them toward each other to zoom out.
	You can also double-tap a photo or webpage to zoom in, and double-tap again to zoom out.

In Maps, double-tap and hold, then drag up to zoom in or drag down to zoom out.




#### 5. Navigating your iPhone
