First Aid Requirements for Healthcare Facilities

Do You Know...

- The **location** of your first aid kit/ supplies?
- Who your first aiders are?
- What to do in case you or another staff gets hurt or has a medical emergency?
- Directors/ Managers shall ensure that there is always a First Aider available, having an adequate number to cover holidays and sickness.
- First Aid Equipment and supplies must be available and accessible at all times while employees are in the workplace.
- First aider or the appointed person, in conjunction with their manager, shall be responsible for stocking the first aid kits to ensure adequate supplies are available.
- A personal first aid kit must be provided to workers who work alone and do not have ready access to a first aid kit.

Remember!

- All units with First Aid Kits must be checked monthly to ensure they are properly stocked.
- All work-related injuries and illnesses must be promptly reported by following the Work-Related Injury/Near Miss (INM) process.
