The Winnipeg Regional Health Authority is responsible for establishing and maintaining an Occupational Safety and Health Program through:

- 1 The organization of resources to establish and maintain appropriate policies, procedures, training programs and best practices.
- 2 Promoting an organizational culture that ensures the highest possible occupational health and safety standards for all workers.
- 3 Securing workers and other persons from risks to their safety, health and welfare arising out of or in connection with activities in their workplace.
- 4 Promoting the highest degree of physical, mental and social well-being of its workers.
- 5 Ensuring that Senior Management, Managers and Supervisors, and Workers recognize and understand their unique and critical role to ensure a safe and healthy workplace.
- 6 Working in consultation with all Workplace Safety and Health Committees and Representatives regarding the health and safety of the organization.
- 7 Ensuring compliance with all applicable Federal and Provincial Legislation governing safety and health.
- 8 Expecting all persons associated with the Winnipeg Regional Health Authority to protect themselves, patients, fellow workers, the public and the Winnipeg Regional Health Authority's property while performing their work.
