Designated Entrances to Support Enhanced Screening

New designated entrances to support enhanced screening

As part of the coordinated approach to preventing the spread of COVID-19, WRHA is taking appropriate measure to protect our staff, patients and visitors. These ongoing measures change how the public and staff enter many of our buildings.

Effective immediately, we will direct all traffic, including staff and members of the public to the following entrances, all other entrances will remain closed. Signage will direct staff, patient and visitors to these designated entry points where they will be screened prior to entry.

Refer to the Shared Health site for ongoing updates to visitor restrictions and screening at entry points.

Concordia Hospital

- ✓ 1095 Concordia Ave - Main Floor Front Entrance (Open 8am –7pm x 7 days for public only).
- ✓ 1095 Concordia Ave - Lower Level Community Clinic Entrance (Open 8am - 5pm – Monday-Friday for public only).
- ✓ Two Staff Entrances are open for enhanced screening. These two entrances CP tunnel entrance and Materials Management entrance facing Kimberly Avenue and nearest staff parking. (Map on our website).

Deer Lodge Centre

- ✓ Main Portage Avenue entrance (2109 Portage).
- ✓ The Lodge Avenue entrance is locked and now staffed by Security for WFPS access only.
- ✓ North Pavilion has Security staff and is for Operational Stress Injury Clinic client access only.

Grace Hospital

- ✓ Access in only two locations - Main Lobby and Emergency Department (300 Booth Dr).



Misericordia Health Centre

- 99 Cornish Ave (patients only) 24/7.
- Sherbrook Ave parking overpass (patients and staff) 24/7.
- Wolseley Ave (patients and staff) Monday – Friday 6am-6pm.

Riverview Health Centre

- Public access will be limited to main entrance only (1 Morley Ave).
- Staff to access for day or evening shift via main entrance or south entrance, for screening. For night shift, all staff access is south entrance only.
- Access to all buildings by tunnel will remain.
- Day Hospital/EMG Clinic door to be locked and staff will unlock for clients only (occasional urgent clients attending, and will be screened upon arrival).

Seven Oaks General Hospital

- Staff entrance is through Wellness Institute.
- Urgent Care entrance off McPhillips St. for patients requiring UC only.
- Front Entrance (Leila Avenue). Patients, including Renal patients and visitors. Not staff.

St. Boniface Hospital

- Access in only two locations – 409 Tache Ave - Everett Atrium (all staff and patients) and South Entrance (Cancer Care and Cardiac patients ONLY).
- D Block Entrance for Non Clinical Staff.

Additional entrance points that will have limited access include:

- Research Centre – locked and limited to staff working there
- McEwen (mental health building) –locked and limited to staff working there
- MRI – locked and limited to staff working there (Patients will be screened as they present – for as long as there is outpatient MRI's occurring)
- Asper (Cardiac) – locked and limited to staff working there
- C Block entrance (access to Hemodialysis on 4C) – locked and limited to entry of Hemodialysis patients only

Victoria General Hospital

- Members of the public access at 2340 Pembina Highway - Front Entrance and Urgent Care (Dartmouth Drive); Ambulance and Stretcher service through ambulance bays.
- All staff enter through the front entrance to be screened.
