Non-Ambulatory Patient Discharge Following Successful Treatment

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Preamble

- Confirm with the Site Medical Director and Infection Prevention & Control the HCP case has been deemed recovered
- Determine whether the patient is to be discharged home or transferred to another facility/ward
- Verify transport arrangements are in place and if applicable, receiving facility/ward is aware of transfer
- Review this checklist and consider additional staff required to carry out the discharge process, including number of Primary healthcare workers (HCWs) required to safely bathe, roll, and transfer the patient
 - Two sets of Primary HCWs are recommended. The first set of Primary HCWs will be responsible for bathing and preparing the patient to exit the patient room. The second set of Primary HCWs will transport the patient to a clean room for a second bath before transporting off the unit

Note: the second set of Primary HCWs may return to their pre-JK3 location after assisting with this protocol, as the patient is already recovered, and would have had an initial bath

- Anteroom door is the door between the hallway and anteroom
- Patient room door is the door between the anteroom and patient room
- If the Primary+ has soiled scrubs, proceed to the Soiled Scrubs Checklist as determined by the Monitor♠
- Ensure staff are aware of roles and are ready to begin the discharge process
- Gather necessary equipment and supplies (i.e., stretcher chair, towels, linens, soap, clean clothing, disinfectant mats)
- Set up a second clean room for giving patient a second bath and dressing prior to exiting the unit. This room will require the following items in addition to anything else the team may consider/anticipate:
 - Anteroom set up for doffing PPE
 - Red waste bin and a blue drum inside the room for disposing of biomedical waste
 - Bed with clean sheets
 - Bathing supplies, patient's clean clothing, Accel Intervention solution/wipes, glove hygiene station, disinfectant mats

Process:

1. Housekeeping Monitor∇

Direct Housekeeping to:

Disinfect all surfaces within the patient room and anteroom with Accel Intervention solution/wipes while the patient is still in the room; this includes the bed.

Mop floors with Accel Intervention solution, from the patient room to anteroom door

Direct Assistant 1Ω to clear the corridor and maintain a clear corridor until discharge complete and corridor disinfected by Housekeeping

15. Housekeeping Monitor ∇

Direct Housekeeping to complete the following, using task specific checklists:

Clean and disinfect the anteroom, including mopping of floor

Remove biomedical waste from anteroom

16. Assistant Ω

Place disinfectant mat in hall just outside anteroom door

17. Monitor 3 φ

Direct Primary 3+ to:

Enter room in clean PPE

Roll patient on stretcher chair out of the patient room, into the hall

Return into room and wait until anteroom clear and Monitor 3 ϕ has an Assistant 1 Ω available for doffing

18. Assistant 1Ω

Receive patient in the hall

Ensure wheels of stretcher chair maintain contact with disinfectant mat

Roll patient on stretcher chair to unit's exit corridor where patient will be received by clean transport staff

Once the patient has exited unit:

- Return stretcher chair to the room to ensure inclusion in the discharge cleaning/disinfection
- Dispose of disinfectant mats in the hallway as biomedical waste in the anteroom's blue drum
- Doff PPE in the anteroom

19. Housekeeping Monitor ∇

Direct **Housekeeping** to:

Perform discharge cleaning/disinfection as per the HCP Operational Directive and the Isolation Room Discharge Cleaning by Housekeeping protocol
