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#### **Soiled Scrubs Decontamination**

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#### **Preamble**

 A PPE breach occurs when the protective layer of PPE has been broken and either unprotected skin or underclothing (i.e., scrubs) is exposed while the healthcare worker is present in the patient room or anteroom. This may include: coverall tear; base glove tear, or dislodging facial protection.

- A breach may be identified:
  - o during patient care
  - o during inspection of one's PPE before exiting the patient's room
  - during doffing of PPE in anteroom
- When a PPE breach is suspected or evident the Primary+ or Assistant 1Ω will immediately notify the Monitor. All activity will stop and the type and extent of the breach will be assessed. If the Primary+ is in the patient room, the Monitor will provide step by step directions for the Primary+ to prevent further self-contamination and safely exit into the anteroom to begin the doffing process. Visible contamination of PPE must be immediately cleaned with a disinfectant wipe.
- If any piece of PPE is determined to be breached, regardless of how the breach has occurred, an
  Occupational and Environmental Safety and Health (OESH) exposure risk assessment is required.
  OESH will provide guidance on follow-up steps and post-exposure monitoring, depending on assessed
  exposure risk.
- Immediately notify the HCPU physician to conduct an exposure risk assessment.
- PPE may be damaged without resulting in an actionable breach (e.g., where a gown is damaged and coveralls underneath remain completely intact). Unsoiled coveralls brushing up against the HCW's scrubs, does not imply a Soiled Scrubs Decontamination event is required.
- It is important to recognize concurrent activities throughout this process
- Monitor will notify unit support staff of PPE breach requiring activation of the Soiled Scrubs
  Decontamination event checklist.
- Unit Support Staff (UA/NA) will request assistance for a soiled scrubs event through a Vocera broadcast. Request:
  - o Environmental Services Aide 1♦
  - Monitor 3φ
  - Shower Room Assistant◆
- The Primary+ refers to the healthcare worker who has been identified as having a Soiled Scrubs event
- Unit Charge Nurse to ensure there is adequate staff and monitors available for ongoing patient care
- Throughout the checklist, IP&C approved disinfectant will be referred to as disinfectant.
- Anteroom door is the door between the hallway and anteroom
- Patient room door is the door between the anteroom and patient room
- Glove hygiene process
  - o Immerse gloved hands into basin and rub together in disinfectant solution without splashing
  - Pat gloves dry with disinfectant wipe(s)



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#### Decontamination Shower Room set up and supplies (JK3 Room #5)

The Shower Room will be set up and maintained with the following supplies for a soiled scrubs event.

- o Sharps container
- o Blue drum set up near shower
- Disinfectant solution (4 bottles needed)
- Disinfectant wipes (1 container)
- o Basin
- Shower Kit Supply bag with the following
  - 2 pairs of Scissors
  - 4 Face cloths
  - Chlorhexidine gluconate (CHG) soap
- o Table for Shower Room Kit supplies (listed below) and glove hygiene basin near shower
- Table for Post Shower Kit contents (listed below) placed on opposite side of room from shower
- Regular waste bin with black garbage bag
- Alcohol Based Hand Rub (ABHR)
- Mop supplies
- o Clean chair for Primary to sit on after shower while waiting to exit room
- Shower Room Anteroom:
  - o Blue drum set up
  - Walk-off disinfectant mats (inserts applied & saturated with Accel Intervention RTU when checklist activated)
  - Table for glove hygiene
  - o 2 basins
  - Disinfectant wipes
  - Disinfectant solution
  - o ABHR
- Shower Room Supply Kit contents (ensure these are prepared and available):
  - Disinfectant solution (4 bottles needed)
  - o Basin
  - o 2 pairs of scissors
  - 4 face cloths
  - o Chlorhexidine gluconate (CHG) soap (new bottle needed for each shower)
- Post Shower Kit contents (ensure these are prepared and labeled with size of scrubs):
  - o 3 to 4 towels for drying off after shower
  - Facility provided scrubs (select appropriate size needed for staff member with soiled scrubs)
  - Shoe covers
  - o Clean Vocera

**Personal Hygiene Kit** (personal hygiene items provided to staff <u>following</u> the decontamination shower):

- Shampoo and conditioner
- Soap
- o Lotion
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Deodorant



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#### **Hallway Supplies**

- Mop with microfibre
- o Pail
- o Disinfectant solution

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
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#### **APPENDIX A**

# How to Clean your Skin with Chlorhexidine Soap



- Take off Clothes
  - Remove under clothing and put them on the floor outside of the shower
- Turn on Water
  Turn on the shower water and set the water to a comfortable temperature
- Start Shower

  Step into the shower and let the water wet your skin and hair, especially where the area that was soiled
- Apply Chlorhexidine (CHG) Soap
  - Step outside of water stream
  - Put CHG soap on your body from your neck down to your feet. DO NOT put CHG soap on your genitals, face or hair.
    - If soiling was to your hair, the use of CHG soap is recommended.
  - Use a washcloth to gently rub the soap into your skin, making sure it covers everywhere
- Wait 5 minutes do not return to shower
  - Tell healthcare worker that CHG soap has been applied so they can set a timer for 5 minutes
  - Leave CHG soap on your skin for 5 minutes
- Rinse Off
  - When healthcare worker tells you, step back into the shower and rinse off CHG soap
  - Remain in the shower with water running until you are told to turn it off
