

Rheumatologist

Description:

Shared Health (1502-155 Carlton Street, Winnipeg MB R3C 3H8) and The University of Manitoba, Department of Internal Medicine (business addresses noted below), are inviting applications for a full-time Rheumatologist to fill our labour shortage in Manitoba. Main job duties include diagnose and treatment of diseases, prescribing medications and treatment, ordering lab tests and x-rays and other diagnostic procedures, consulting with other physicians as required, and medical research, which job duties encompass 90% of the position. Job duties are required in English.

The successful candidate would also be eligible for appointment at the rank of Assistant Professor, and appointed as a geographical full-time member of the Max Rady College of Medicine, Rady Faculty of Health Sciences at the University of Manitoba, which job duties encompasses 10% of the position. Job duties are required in English.

The Section has access to substantial resources within the health system, primarily at two academic health centres and one community-based hospital. There are presently 7 full-time academic Rheumatology physicians within the Section with major clinical and investigative responsibilities in Rheumatology, and additional part time members.

Qualifications:

The successful candidate must hold a Doctor of Medicine Degree with specialization in Rheumatology. The successful candidate must be eligible for certification with the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, and licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Manitoba. The successful candidate will have a proven track record in the care of complex rheumatology patients including systemic autoimmune disease, vasculitis and inflammatory arthritis and experience in clinical rheumatology research. Five + years experience preferred.

Compensation:

Compensation is derived from fee-for-service income (\$250,000+/annum) and an additional stipend of \$5,375.00/annually.
