Subject: ACTION REQUIRED – Change to Manitoba Workplace Safety and Health Regulations

The MB Workplace Safety and Health Regulation 217/ 2006 (Part 5 - First Aid) has recently been updated to include specific CSA requirements for first aid kits:

First aid kits required

5.12(1) An employer must provide and keep readily accessible the type, size, and number of first aid kits meeting the requirements set out in CSA Z1220-17, first aid kits for the workplace.

Due to this change, the required list of contents of a basic first aid kit must now include an emergency blanket, aluminized, non- stretch polyester, minimum 132 x 213 cm (52 x 84 inches).

If your area/ department currently maintains or requires a basic first aid kit, please ensure that it includes an aluminized blanket. If you need an aluminized blanket or require a first aid kit, use the following SAP #:

- 331990 aluminized blanket ONLY
- 319778 metal case first aid kit (includes aluminized blanket) .
- 203675- plastic case first aid kit (includes aluminized blanket) •
- 351339- refill bag (includes aluminized blanket)

Note that contents of all first aid kits mentioned above comply with the applicable CSA standard.
