Welcome to Rapid Response Nursing

Rapid Response Nursing is a short term Home Care service (2 -3 weeks) to help you understand your chronic disease and support you in managing your health needs independently.

What can I expect:

- **A nurse will be calling you within a day or two to set up an appointment to visit you at home.**
- The nurse will help you understand your chronic disease and the medications you are taking.
- The nurse will also review your discharge plan from hospital and assist you with any difficulties in making any follow-up appointments.
- Together, you and the nurse will identify goals and create a health care plan that works for you.
- The nurse will contact your Primary Care Clinic (doctor/ nurse practitioner/clinic) to share this information.
- If you do not have a Primary Care Clinic, the nurse will help you to find one.
- If you need other community supports, the nurse will help to arrange them.
- The nurse may make additional visits or call you by phone.

As a team working together, we will help you to get the right care, in the right place, at the right time.
