All volunteers will know what to do in case of a fire and how to respond to a fire alarm.

GOOD PRACTICE GUIDELINES:

- 1. During their orientation, all volunteers will receive training on fire procedures pertaining to the WRHA site where they will be located. All volunteers will adhere to all fire regulations.
- 2. The volunteer's placement supervisor will review the fire safety plan relevant to the site where the volunteer will be located.
- 3. The WRHA Manager of Volunteer Services will review the section of the volunteer handbook on fire safety with the appropriate operations directors prior to reprinting.
