ACP-M. What does it mean?

As demographics and medical illness burdens change in our society, advanced care planning is starting to come to the forefront. Unfortunately, many people have not completed a care plan nor have they discussed this with family or their health care team. The lack of a plan results in worse quality of life for patients and families. People want their health care provider to give them information about advance care planning. It is important for health care providers to understand the purpose and limitation of advance care plans and to initiate discussions early.
