Putting on Personal Protective Equipment

Before entering anteroom:

DON DISPOSABLE SCRUBS AND DEDICATED SHOES

- Don disposable scrubs and dedicated shoes
- Remove lanyards and pull back hair from face; securely tie/pin back as required
- Visually inspect PPE to ensure all items are in serviceable condition.

Perform hand hygiene (HH) with alcohol-based

hand rub (ABHR) unless visibly soiled; wash if soiled

GLOVES

Don inner set of **BLUE** extended cuff (longer and closer-fitting) gloves



4

COVERALLS

- Don coveralls; pull hood over head, zip up & secure adhesive over zipper.
- Ensure cuffs of BLUE gloves are under coveralls and hair is tucked under hood



5

SHOE / LEG COVERS

Don shoe/leg covers; pull to knees and securely over feet to avoid risk of tripping

GOWN

Don gown so gown edges overlap; ensure cuffs of **BLUE** gloves are under the gown

N95 Respirator Don N95 respirator

and perform seal check

FACE SHIELD

Don full face shield ensuring full face coverage

MONITOR CHECK

Check PPE placement/integrity and log room entry on EVD Room Entrance Log

Taking off Personal Protective Equipment

Before leaving isolation room:

1 PERFORM GLOVE HYGIENE
Immerse gloved hands into basin
and carefully rub together in Accel
Intervention RTU; no splashing



DOOR HANDLE
Disinfect door handle and plate with
Accel Intervention wipe; wait 1 minute
before entering anteroom

After Primary enters anteroom,
Assistant may enter. Both to stay

7 GOWN
Primary:
Turn and face away from Assistant

Assistant:

Undo neck and waist ties; grasp gown at shoulders and ease gown to midway down upper arm

Primary:

Turn and face Assistant; hook fingers under opposite cuff; pull gown over hand; use gown covered hand to pull gown over hand; pull gown off without touching outside of gown; roll up inside out; place in no-touch waste receptacle





PERFORM GLOVE HYGIENEPrimary and Assistant

9 SHOE / LEG COVERS

Assistant:

Peel Primary's shoe/ leg covers down by handling outside; direct Primary to lift heel; Assistant to remove without touching coverall; repeat with other leg; place in no-touch waste receptacle



10 PERFORM GLOVE HYGIENE Assistant

FACE SHIELD Primary:

Lean forward and grasp strap at back of head; close eyes; slowly remove in forward and down motion. Place in no-touch waste receptacle



12 PERFORM GLOVE HYGIENE Primary

12 N95 RESPIRATOR

Primary:

Grasp elastics at back of head; close eyes; slowly remove in forward and down motion. Place in no-touch waste receptacle

14 PERFORM GLOVE HYGIENE Primary

15 COVERALLS

Primary:

Face Assistant; tilt head/chin upward; keep eyes closed

Assistant: Undo adhesive; carefully unzip **Primary:** Turn away from Assistant

Assistant:

Use top of hood to carefully uncover hood from head Grasp suit by shoulders. Peel suit downwards to expose shoulders. Use outside of sleeves to remove one sleeve at a time. Carefully roll downward, remove leg portions similar to removal of shoe/leg covers. If contaminated surfaces of coveralls contact shoes during removel, wipe shoes with Accel Intervention wipes; ensure 1 minute contact time; allow to air dry. Place in no-touch waste receptacle









16 PERFORM GLOVE HYGIENE Primary and Assistant

17 GLOVES

Doff inner **BLUE** gloves, using glove-to-glove, skin-to-skin technique



18 PERFORM HAND HYGIENE Primary

19 EXIT

Assistant: Turn and face the wall

Primary:

Before exiting anteroom, until neck and waist ties of Assistant. Perform hand hygiene with ABHR outside of anteroom and log room exit on EVD Room Entrance Log
