

IDENTIFICATION OF THE FRANCOPHONE PATIENT

IN THE EMERGENCY RESPONSE INFORMATION KIT (E.R.I.K.)

Canadians are increasingly recognizing the value of having an advance care plan and making your wishes known to those who can speak for you if you cannot speak for yourself. But what if there is no one who can advocate on your behalf or the person you have chosen to communicate your wishes for you is unavailable? An Emergency Response Information Kit or E.R.I.K. can help. And, what if you're preferred language is French? The Francophone patient/client identifier sticker can help.

This project is intended to improve flow, safety and quality of care. The kit is ideal for seniors, kids, newcomers, chronically ill persons, those who live alone or have caregivers, and those with speech or language difficulties.

The Francophone identification sticker can help to identify francophone patients well in advance in order to match them to an appropriate designated bilingual facility or service provider.
