Use Your French If you want to.

You do not have to be in a Designated Bilingual Position to use your French. You can use as little or as much as you want to. You can start your conversation in French, chit chat a little to put your patient at ease and then switch to English as you move into more complex or clinical components of the appointment. Or, carry on in French if you have the confidence to do so. Don't have all the medical vocabulary? You can throw in the medical terms in English.
