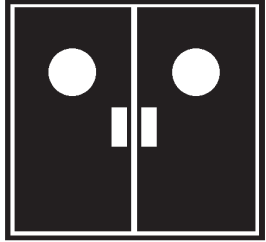
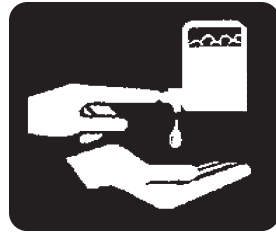


AIRBORNE/CONTACT PRECAUTIONS



PATIENT PLACEMENT

- Door closed
- Single room



HAND HYGIENE

- Follow Routine Practices
- Before entering the room
- Before leaving the room
- After removing the N95 respirator



GLOVES

- Before entering the room or bed space
- Remove before leaving room or bed space
- Between procedures if contamination has occurred



GOWN

- For direct contact with patient or surfaces and objects in room
- Remove before leaving room



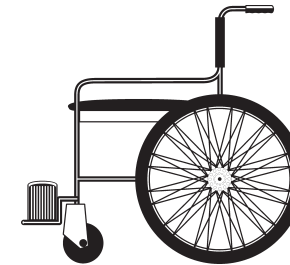
RESPIRATOR

- N95 respirator upon entering the room
- Remove after leaving room



PATIENT CARE EQUIPMENT

- Dedicated equipment or clean/disinfect between use



PATIENT TRANSPORT

- Patient wears surgical/procedure mask
- Transporter wears N95 respirator
- Transport for medically essential purposes only
- Notify receiving department in advance
