

DROPLET/CONTACT PRECAUTIONS



PATIENT PLACEMENT

- Single room preferred
- Consult ICP for co-horting
- Door may remain open
- If shared room:
 - At least 2 metres between people in care;
 - Draw curtains



HAND HYGIENE

- Before providing care or contact with the care environment
- Before aseptic or clean procedures
- After body fluid exposure risk
- After providing care or contact with the care environment



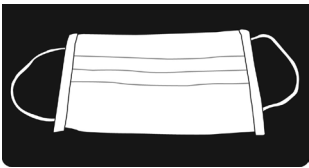
GLOVES

- Before entering the room/bed space
- Remove before leaving room/bed space
- Change between procedures if contaminated



GOWN

- Before entering room/bed space
- Remove before leaving room/bed space
- Change between procedures if contaminated



MASK

- Procedure or surgical mask when entering room or bed space (within 2 metres of person in care)
- Remove after leaving room or bed space



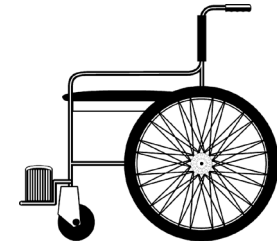
EYE PROTECTION

- Eye protection when entering room or bed space (within 2 metres of person in care)
- Remove after leaving room or bed space



PATIENT CARE EQUIPMENT

- Dedicate equipment or clean and disinfect between uses



PATIENT TRANSPORT

- Transport for medically essential purposes only
- Persons requiring precautions wears a surgical or procedure mask and performs hand hygiene
- Staff to put on clean PPE
- Notify receiving department in advance
