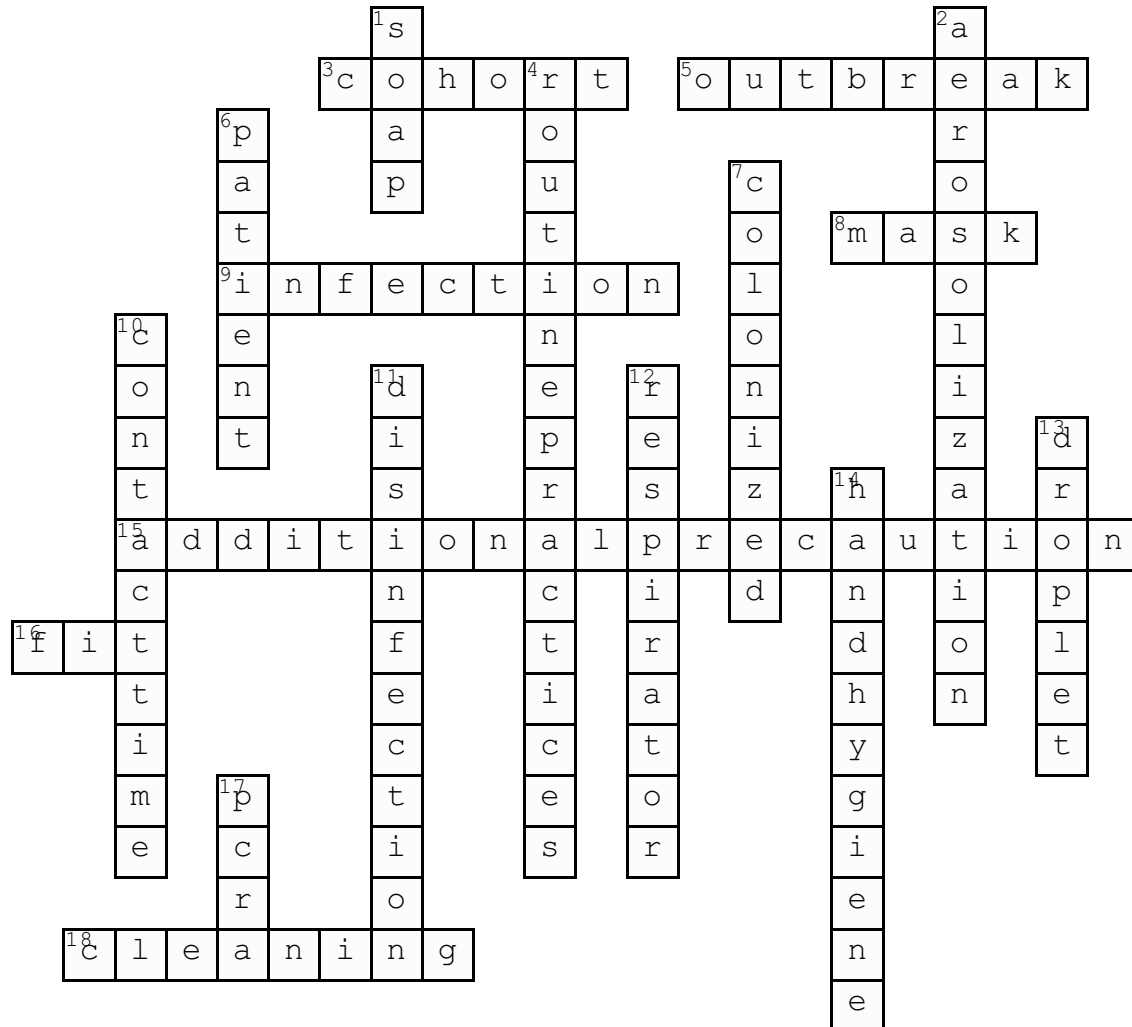


# WRHA Infection Control Crossword
