

## **Standard Worksheet**

Process:	Cleaning and Disinfection of Kego™ Oxygen Tank Bags
Preamble:	Kego™ oxygen tank bags are dedicated to a single patient/resident/client (P/R/C)
	<ul> <li>Prevention of infection transmission in all healthcare settings</li> <li>Reduce healthcare acquired infections</li> </ul>

- ☑ Standardize cleaning and disinfection for Kego<sup>™</sup> oxygen tank bags
- ☑ Provide clean oxygen tank bags prior to use

CLEANING FREQUENCY	Between users, when visibly soiled, after additional precautions discontinued and when dedicated to one P/R/C (ideally) once a week or at minimum once per month
RESPONSIBILITY	Whoever assists the P/R/C with the oxygen tank is responsible for sending the Kego™ oxygen tank bag for laundering

STEP	PREPARATION
	Perform hand hygiene and put on Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) as indicated by Additional Precautions and/or Point of Care Risk Assessment (PCRA).
1	PPE may include:
	Gloves
	<ul> <li>Gown, eye protection and mask based on PCRA - if splash is anticipated</li> </ul>
2	Inspect bag for breakage, or wear – if damaged, flag for repair or dispose (follow manager's or equipment team's direction for disposal)



STEP	LAUNDERING OF KEGO™ OXYGEN TANK BAGS
1	After use, if the bag is not visibly soiled, store in a clean dry place in the P/R/C room/bed space
2	<ul> <li>Put bag in laundry for any of the following reasons:</li> <li>visibly soiled</li> <li>when it is to be used on a different P/R/C</li> <li>it is the scheduled laundry time</li> <li>after discontinuation of additional precautions not mentioned below</li> </ul>
3	Kego <sup>™</sup> oxygen tank bags used with a P/R/C on additional precautions for bed bugs or Crusted/Norwegian Scabies are to be disposed of as bags will not tolerate high temperature laundering ( <i>follow manager's or equipment team's direction for disposal</i> )
4	Kego <sup>™</sup> oxygen tank bags used with a P/R/C on additional precautions for typical Scabies are to be placed into an air and water-tight plastic bag for 7 days and then laundered
5	Kego <sup>™</sup> oxygen tank bags used with a P/R/C on additional precautions for Lice (Pediculosis) are to be placed into an air and water-tight plastic bag for 10 days and then laundered
6	Remove gloves if used; remove other PPE if used
7	Perform hand hygiene
8	Laundering Instructions: Kego™ oxygen tank bags are to be machine washed using a cool temperature cycle and hung to dry
