

Population Public Health Program Management Team Terms of Reference

Preamble:

The Population Public Health program has several responsibilities including;

- Program support for community area operations (practice, information systems, planning and quality).
- Management of population and public health centralized services
- Population Health Promotion and Injury Prevention services

Purpose:

- The Primary focus of the Population and Public Health Management team (PPHMT) will be to guide and support the overall strategic direction and development of PPH community area services within the WRHA. This would include contributing to and making recommendations to the work of the PPH committees (information systems, quality, practice, planning, and oversight of financial situation). It also includes decision making regarding recommendations from the Population and Public Health Operations Team.
- The Program Management Team will facilitate consistency and support improvements in services across centralized and decentralized programs where applicable.
- To facilitate ongoing integration of PPH services within Winnipeg Integrated Services structure.
- The PPH Program Management Team will ensure the vision, mission and principles of PPH services support the strategic direction of the WRHA vision, mission, values and strategic priorities. Members of the PPH Program Management Team will contribute to the development of regional population health promotion and injury prevention strategies in collaboration with other regional programs and partners through the Community Health Services Leadership Team and other related mechanisms.
- The PPH Program Management Team will contribute to and develop strategies related to opportunities for population health promotion/injury prevention initiatives within the community area teams.
