

## PHIMs (Public Health Information Management System) Orientation for Public Health Nurses

PHIMs (formerly known as Panorama) is a provincial electronic public health record used to manage information for immunizations, vaccine inventory, communicable diseases/investigations and outbreaks.

Prerequisites for PHIMs training are review of the PHIMs Primer videos, the Privacy and Disclosure Directives in PHIMs for End Users, signed Terms of Use Agreement and attend a 1 day in person training session. During the 1 day session, the AM is an introduction to PHIMs and will provide the knowledge for how to use the PHIMs program to access immunization records and how to document immunizations provided to individuals. The PM will focus on the use of PHIMs when providing immunizations to clients within a Mass Event (ie: school, flu, outreach clinics)
