## Core Standards – Frequently Asked Questions

### Which Accreditation Standards apply to all programs, sites and community areas?

There are three regional standards that apply to all WRHA programs, sites and community areas. These are:

- Infection Prevention and Control (IPC)
- Medication Management
- Population Health & Wellness

### How many of the core standards will I be invited to respond to?

Depending upon your role, you may be asked to respond to more than one questionnaire.

### Why do the questionnaires ask for information about my job category and where I work?

This information is used to direct and focus our quality improvement activities. It breaks down the data and makes it possible to identify trends by job categories or locations. It does not identify individual staff.
