## Overview:

The Crisis Prevention Institute (CPI) developed the Nonviolent Crisis Intervention Training (NVCI) in the late 1960's. It is a highly recommended and well-recognized national and international workshop that teaches basic crisis intervention techniques to defuse disruptive and assaultive behavior. NVCI is often a mandatory requirement for employees of health care organizations.

### What you will learn:

- ✓ How to identify behaviors that could lead to a crisis
- ✓ How to respond to prevent the situation from escalating
- ✓ How to use verbal and nonverbal techniques to resolve a crisis before it becomes violent
- ✓ How to use principles of personal safety to avoid injury if behavior becomes physical
- ✓ How to develop team intervention strategies and techniques
- ✓ How to maintain rapport with the acting-out individual
- ✓ Key steps for debriefing after a crisis
