

Did you know that immunization rates of Meningococcal vaccine have decreased over the last few years?

Since 2018 immunization rates that protect against meningococcal disease have decreased from 83% to 69%.

Meningococcal disease is a Bacterial infection that can result in meningitis or septicemia. It can cause severe illness and sometimes death. Incidence of Meningococcal disease in Canada are low, according to public health agency of Canada between 2012 and 2019, 983 cases were identified across Canada. Although the rates of meningococcal disease are low, the outcomes of those infected can be severe. Immunization is one of the best tools to decrease these risks!
