3. Personal Interview

Successful completion of the Interpreter Training Program is a condition of employment to be achieved prior to hiring as a casual Interpreter with Language Access Interpreter Services, Shared Health. Training seats will only be offered to candidates who are being considered for this employment opportunity.

The training is offered to selected participants at no cost with support from the Province of Manitoba. The professional curriculum is delivered by experienced facilitators and was developed based on the Code of Ethics & Standards of Practice for Interpreters. Learners are introduced to the core competencies and professional standards required for interpreters as well as an introduction to medical terminology.
