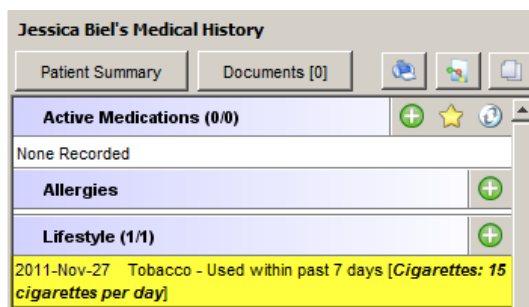
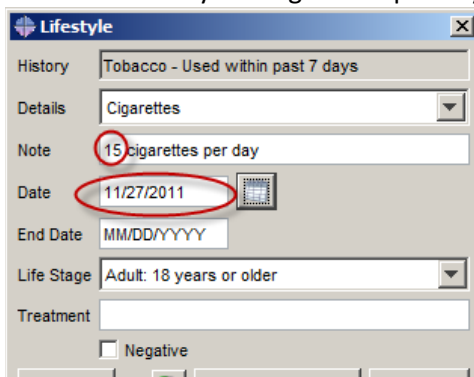
Follow the same steps as indicated in Scenario #4 to populate the Lifestyle band to indicate that the client was smoking 10 cigarettes per day as of June 20, 2010. Your band should look like this:



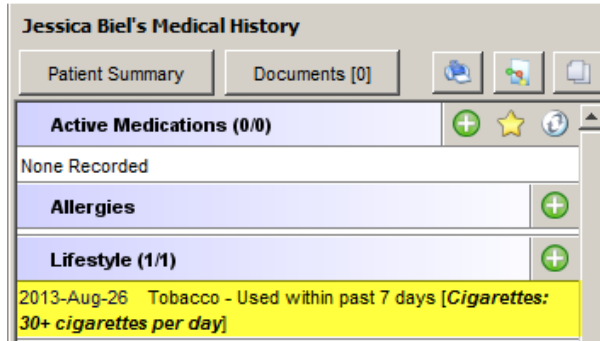
When you see the client on November 27, 2011, she indicates that she is now smoking 15 cigarettes per day. Instead of adding a new entry, you simply left click once on the item in the Lifestyle band to open up the Lifestyle window for that item:




Modify the Note to now say: 15 cigarettes per day and change the Date field to November 27, 2011. Click Save and Close:



When you see the client on August 26 2013, she indicates that she is now smoking 30+ cigarettes per day. Again, open the Lifestyle window to modify the information. You will now see the following in your Lifestyle band:



You notice that she has increased her quantity of cigarette smoking and would like to see the History. Left click on the item in the Lifestyle band to open up the Lifestyle window for that item and click on the  button. This will display the dates the information was added and what the content was previously (please note that as I entered this sample data all on the same day, the dates on the left are all the same – real data will be more accurate). Click on one of the items in the left window to view the historical data:
