

# Introducing Rapid Access to Consultative Expertise

The Manitoba College of Family Physicians and the WRHA Mental Health Program, is excited to introduce a new service available to Family Physicians in Manitoba. The **Rapid Access to Consultative Expertise** or **RACE** program is a telephone service that allows Family Physicians to access a psychiatry consultant for telephone advice by calling one central number. This service is intended for Physicians who have an ongoing relationship with their patients. The launch date has been set for June 1, 2016.

## The goal is to improve care for patients with psychiatric conditions through:

Access to early psychiatric advice for mental health patients in a Primary Care practice Advice on treatment adjustments

Reduction in low-priority office referrals

Ongoing information transfer and continuing education

Promotion of ambulatory health and reduction in hospital admissions

Support on choice and timing of investigations

#### **RACE Provides**

Enhanced ability to manage the patient in your office
An opportunity to speak directly with a Psychiatrist
Timely guidance and advice
Assistance with plan of care
Learning opportunity

#### **RACE Does Not Provide**

Appointment booking
Arranging transfer
Arranging for laboratory or diagnostic investigations
Informing the referring physician of results of diagnostic investigations
Arranging a hospital bed

# Background

This program started in British Columbia and has been very successful.

## The most common reasons for calls in BC are:

General management, diagnostic, therapeutic and recommendations for Medication, additional testing, reassurance of plan

The estimated cost saving to the system was up to \$200/call

#### In BC,

90% of calls are <15 minutes in length.
60% of RACE contacts avoided face-to-face consults
32% of calls avoided ED visits

#### Overall BC has seen:

Improved patient and provider experience Improved efficiencies Improved ED flow Increased specialist capacity

We are hoping that RACE will be a positive experience in Manitoba and provide Family Physicians with timely access to expert advice and enhance patient care.
