Safe Work Procedure (SWP)

Name of Task: Log Roll for Spinal Precautions on bed or stretcher		
Description: Rolling patient with spinal precautions		
Position/Job Minimum 3 Healthcare Workers (HCWs) Department/Unit: All patient care	areas	
Equipment and/or Tools required: Personal Protective Equipment	Required	
Height adjustable bed or stretcher Appropriate footwear for HCW.		
Spine board if needed		
Potential Hazards: Forceful movements, awkward positions, infection transmission		
Signs and symptoms of a musculoskeletal injury (MSI) can include pain, burning, swelling, stiffness, numbness/tingling, and/or loss of movement or strength in a body part. Report these to your supervisor.		
Considerations:		
 For use with patients suspected or confirmed to have an unstable spine or pelvis fracture 		
 Client may or may not have a cervical collar. 		
 More HCWs are required if the patient has: 		
• Leg cast		
• Central line		
 Drainage tube Behaviour interferes with care 		
 Behaviour interferes with care 		
Steps to be taken to complete task safely:		
1 Place bed/stretcher at waist height of shortest HCW with space for movement of HCWs at both sides and the head of the bed. Ensure brakes are applied.		
2 HCW#1 stands with wide base of support at head of bed in line with patient's head. HCW#1 places forearms on either side of patient's head/jaw, holding onto patient's head and maintaining neck alignment. HCW #1 can bend their elbows and rest them on the mattress.		
3 HCW #2 and HCW #3 stand on one side of the bed with wide base of support, one foot in front of the other. HCW #2 places hands on patient's far shoulder and hip. HCW #3 places hands on patient's far waist and knee. Arms of HCW #2 and #3 will overlap. Additional HCWs may assist with the legs and feet if required.		
4 HCW #1 asks patient to remain motionless. HCW #1 maintains alignment and asks HCW #2 and #3 to roll patient towards themselves. All HCWs work together to weight shift and roll the patient at the same time to a side lying position. HCW#1 ensures control of the head to maintain spinal alignment.		
5 If needed, a spine board can be inserted or removed by additional HCWs. HCWs #1, 2 a maintain patient in side lying position.	and 3 will	
Reverse procedure to return patient to their back on the bed/stretcher.		

Responsibilities

<u>Managers/Supervisors or Designate</u>: Ensure all duties are performed in accordance to training, established health and safety regulations/guidelines, policies and procedures (e.g. following safe work procedures)

<u>Staff performing task</u>: Perform task in accordance to training, established health and safety regulations/guidelines, policies and procedures (e.g. following safe work procedures). Notify Manager/Supervisor or designates of all occurrences/incidents, injuries, illnesses or safety and health concerns which are likely to harm themselves, co-workers, or any others who enter the premises.
