## Hearing Conservation (Noise Survey)

Concern identified or any process, material, or equipment changes/modifications that may have altered the noise exposure levels.


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The Manager/Supervisor will contact OESH to determine what shifts incur the most noise exposure and identify two dates to conduct the testing.



The OESH Workplace Safety & Health Coordinator will perform a workplace noise level assessment.

The OESH Workplace Safety & Health Coordinator will provide reports to the Managers/Directors of the department including recommendations for compliance when applicable.



The OESH Safety Coordinator will file the electronic copies of the testing records in shared drive under Hearing Conservation and provide a copy to the OESH Admin Coordinator.

The OESH Safety Coordinator will

- 1. **Acute Care Sites** Arrange baseline audiometric testing for all affected staff with Protec and will add department staff to the annual audiometric testing schedule.
- HSC The Audiometric Technicians must be notified to arrange baseline audiometric testing for all affected staff and will add department staff to the annual audiometric testing schedule.
- Work with the department Manager/Director to ensure adequate hearing protection is provided for all affected staff and that the department is in compliance with all elements of the WRHA Hearing Conservation Operational Procedure.
