

# Hearing Conservation (Noise Exposure Assessments)

Sound level concern identified or any process, material, or equipment changes/modifications that may have altered the noise exposure levels.



The Manager will contact OESH to request a noise exposure assessment



The OESH Workplace Safety & Health Coordinator will perform noise exposure assessment and provide reports to Managers including recommendations for compliance when applicable.



Is there a sound level concern?

The OESH Safety Coordinator will file the electronic copies of the testing records and reports in shared drive under Hearing Conservation and complete the Integrated Sound Level Spreadsheet.

YES

The OESH Safety Coordinator will

1. **Acute Care Sites** – Provide site OHN with a list of departments requiring baseline and bi-annual audiometric testing.

3. Work with the department Manager to ensure adequate hearing protection is provided for all affected staff and that the department is following all elements of the WRHA Hearing Conservation Operational Procedure.
